TTC Track Replacement and Streetscape Improvements on Wellington Street from Yonge Street to Church Street

Contract: 20ECS-TI-20SP**New Start Date: Spring 2022****New End Date: Summer 2022****Timelines are subject to change and future notice will be provided.*

The streetcar track replacement and streetscape improvement work taking place on Wellington Street will be halted until spring 2022 due to challenges found by the contractor in carrying out the construction work around a complex underground infrastructure located under the road surface.

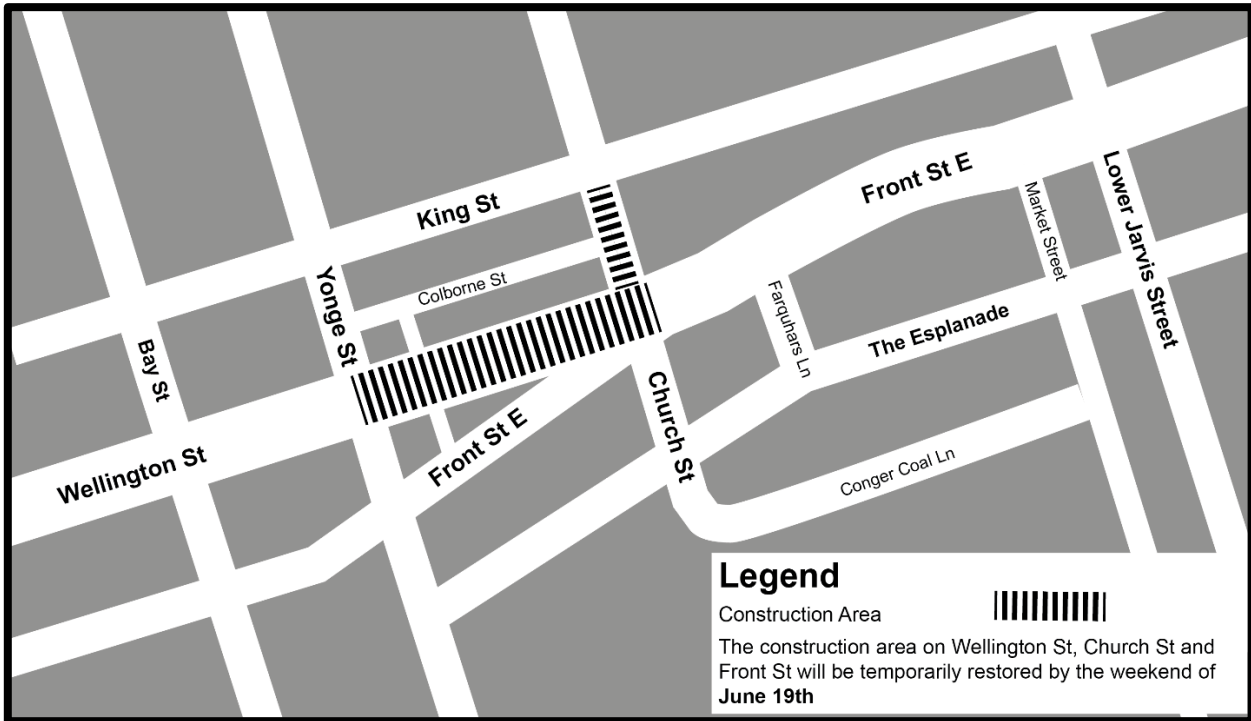
Before making this decision, the City explored a number of different options to address the construction challenges, but has decided that further work is needed on the designs before the contractor can move forward to complete the work. The contractor will restore the work area by June 19. Construction work is expected to resume in the spring of 2022 with an anticipated end date of July 2022. The City will issue a future notification about the resumption of this project in 2022 when a new start date is confirmed.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING DEMOBILIZATION

- The contractor will be demobilizing construction equipment and materials in the Church Street, Wellington Street and Front Street area.
- Wellington Street will be restored to two lanes of westbound traffic.
- All sidewalks along Wellington Street will be temporarily restored.
- All pole bases that are currently exposed along Wellington Street will be temporarily restored.
- All garbage receptacles will be restored to original locations along Wellington Street and Front Street.
